

## Verbale Riunione Giuria/Meeting memo

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of July 2014, the meeting of the International Jury of the seventh edition of the Mare Nostrum Awards 2014 took place at the Maison des Alliances (Naples), regularly called in order to select the winners of the International journalistic award sponsored by the publication *Grimaldi Magazine Mare Nostrum*, published by Grimaldi Group.

The meeting was attended by:

- Folco Quilici, President of the Jury;
- Vassiliki Armogeni, Michele Capasso, Diana De Feo, Irene Hernandez Velasco, Paul Kyprianou, Mimmo Jodice, Mongi Gharbi, Ottavio Lucarelli, members of the Jury;
- Luciano Bosso, Secretary of the Awards;
- Vita Wembagher, Organisation Secretary of the Award.

The members of the Jury had previously received by the Secretariat the works published between the 15<sup>th</sup> of October 2013 and the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 2014, and sent by the 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2014, deadline for the participation to the competition.

The 2014 edition divided the € 50,000 jackpot between six winners, four of which will receive a net amount of € 10,000 each and another two prizes of € 5,000 reserved to participants under 40 years old (born as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1974).

The Jury, after considering the works received, agreed on the possibility of excluding the works not conforming to the theme of the competition, and to consider only those worth of collective examination.

At the end of a wide examination and an internal vote, the Jury decided to award the four prizes of € 10,000 to:

- **Massimo Minella** for the article " Ingorgo Mediterraneo - Si restringe il Mare Nostrum" published in "La Repubblica" on the 24<sup>th</sup> of December 2013;
- **Giovanni Capozzoli** for the television service "Autostrade del Mare, Autostrade d'amare" aired on the channel SeiTV on the 9<sup>th</sup> of May 2014;
- **Marco Molino** for the photo exhibition "The Wave of Stone" held in Procida (Naples) between 26 and March 29 2014 at the School for Higher Education in the University "L'Orientale";
- **Danilo Mainardi** for the article "Guizzo tra le onde" published in "Sette-Corriere della Sera" on the 4<sup>th</sup> of April 2014.

As for the two prizes of € 5,000 each, the Jury, during the vote, didn't consider worth to award the € 5,000 prize to the under 40 second classified, and has therefore decided to award it to the 5<sup>th</sup> classified between the over 40 works. Therefore the two prizes of € 5,000 were awarded to:

- **Kostas-Syligardos** for the Tv reportage entitled "Motorways of the Sea" which aired on the portal flashnews.gr on the 14<sup>th</sup> of May 2014;

- **Claudia Bonasi** and **Antonio Dura** for the exhibition “Salerno-Tunisi, viaggio sulle rotte della ceramica mediterranea”, held from May 9 to 11 at the Arch Palace of Catalan Pinto, Salerno.

During the works, the jury decided to eliminate in the next edition of the Award the division of prizes between under 40 and over 40 years old. Therefore, for the VIII edition of the award, the jackpot will again be divided into five prizes of € 10,000 each.

The jury finally asked the possibility to hold the next meeting of the Award at 11:00 am and not at 3,00 pm.
